Harry C. Parker

Harry grew up in Waterbury Vermont, and graduated from the University of Vermont School of Arts and Sciences in 2009 with a Bachelor's Degree in English with a minor in Philosophy. After expressing an interest in law, he was encouraged to pursue the Vermont Law Office Study Program as an alternative to law school by his father Eric Parker, a partner at the Bauer Gravel Farnham, LLP.

Harry joined the firm in the spring of 2009 and commenced the Vermont Law Office Study Program shortly thereafter. Taking on program applicants has been a longstanding tradition of the firm resulting in the admission of several lawyers. Harry was admitted to the Vermont Bar in October, 2015.

Since that time, he has worked in high volume civil litigation, insurance subrogation, property disputes, real estate, and estate planning focusing on the regulatory environment, implementing best practices, supporting the complex litigation team, and managing several high volume case portfolios.

In 2016, the firm indicated that it needed a full time attorney in its North Hero office at which point Harry moved to North Hero with his wife to join Joseph Bauer, Esq. at the firm's islands office. Joseph Bauer retired in 2018 and Harry took over management of the firm's North Hero office.

Harry has been a director on the Vermont Bar Foundation Board since 2017 and is seeking a second term. He also sits on both the Grants and IOLTA Committees.
